PROSPECTUS

The Council, located in the centre of Koraput, the district headquarters, is a registered body under the Societies Registration Act, 1860 bearing Registration No.712/82 of 1991-92 dated the 28/03/92 and is engaged in study, research and publication centering on tribal life and cultures.

The campus provides a serene atmosphere for study and research. The Library has 7000 number of reference books & Journals and subscribes to 14 Journals. It is situated by the side of a rich tribal museum, depicting various aspects of tribal life. The Council is managed by a Board of Governors with Sri Pyarimohan Mohapatra, Hon'ble Member of Parliament (Rajya Sabha) as its Chairman. The Board of Governors, managing the Institute, consists of reputed scholars of the state, Collectors of undivided Koraput district, Regional Chief Conservator of Forests, representatives of Sri Jagannath temple, Koraput Faculty Members of COATS and tribal communities from Koraput region. It is affiliated to the Berhampur University.

ACADEMIC SESSION :

As per the Berhampur University Regulations (January to December of each year).

CRITERIA FOR SELECTION :

Admission into M.Phil Course shall be done by an entrance test followed by a Viva Voce Test. The test shall comprise of one paper of 100 marks (50 marks objective type of questions and 50 marks for short answer type questions) of two

hours duration. The question paper shall cover broad areas relating to Tribal Studies. The candidate should secure minimum 50% of marks in the entrance test (40% of marks for candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes) in order to be eligible to appear for the Viva-Voce Test. After being selected in the entrance test the selection for admission into M.Phil courses shall be made on the basis of career marks and marks secured in the Viva Voce Test, as detailed below:

1. Career Marks

ADMISSION PROCEDURE:

After receiving the intimation letter the candidate shall report in person with the following documents:

1. Three recent coloured stamp size photographs.
2. T.C/College Leaving Certificate in original.
3. Conduct Certificate in original from the Head of the Institution last attended.
4. University Registration Receipt in original in case of students of Berhampur University.
5. Migration Certificate in case of students of Universities other than Berhampur University. If this certificate cannot be submitted at the time of admission due to any genuine difficulty, the candidate should give an undertaking to the effect that he/she would produce it within fifteen days from the date of admission, failing which the admission may be cancelled.
6. Permission from the Employer to persue the course in the evening hours without hampering normal duties in case of employees.
7. A self-addressed envelope of size 22 X 10 cm affixed with postage stamps worth Rs.30/- (Rupees thirty only).
